Question#1: Part C-2. Environmental Requirements -a.

- For the EPA approved drums, is this the same as DOT Approved / UN Rated drums?
- Can vendor use DOT approved / UN rated cubic yard boxes instead? Boxes would be capable of being store outside.

Answer #1: We prefer the use of any approved 55 gallon seal-able drums instead of UN Rated boxes.

Question #2: Part C-3. Service Requirements

• Please confirm, Contractor is to remove <u>all</u> granular from the traps when performing lead removal service?

Answer #2: Technical Specifications (Part C)(3)(a)(iii) states: "The Vendor shall completely remove granular rubber from trap structure and proceed with lead removal."

Question #3: Part C-3. Service Requirements - c. Indoor Range - iv

• *Is the Sheriff's Office or Contractor providing the filters for replacement?*

Answer #3: The HCSO will supply the filters.

Question #4: Service Schedule: Based on the past recovery totals shared, Contractor suggests lead recovery services could be performed every 2-3 years before reaching trap capacity, rather than every 6-12 months.

Answer #4: Contractor shall base service frequency on what is published in the RFP.
